APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Name: Gallia County Emancipation Proclamation Scholarship

Address: P O Box 511, Gallipolis, Ohio 45631

Concentration: All areas of Collegiate Study

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be African-American, undergraduate student (applicants are only eligible to receive the scholarship for 4 undergraduate years), does not have to be consecutive years
- Be enrolled full-time at a college, university or technical school in the United States
- Be a resident of Gallia County since beginning of high school junior year
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident residing in the United States
- Minimum high school or college GPA of 2.5 for the prior school year
- Award is to be used solely for room, board, fees, books and/or tuition at any accredited degree granting college, university or technical school in the United States
- REQUIREMENT: Confirmation must be provided by 9/1/2020 (i.e., copy of course & fee statement or equivalent documentation) of full-time fall enrollment occurring during the Grant Award Year to the Emancipation Scholarship Committee before the scholarship check will be issued
- Applicant must attend a minimum of 12 credit hours to considered full-time
- NOTE: If a scenario is not stated in the application instructions it is NOT allowed.

Evaluation Criteria:

Applicants will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

1. Academic achievement (official high school or college/university/technical school transcript with GPA, ACT or SAT scores must be attached to the application – without this documentation your application will not be considered),
2. An essay due with the initial application only (2 typed pages minimum) expressing the impact of the Emancipation proclamation on the United States and the significance of the Gallia County Celebration on your personal life,
3. Minimum 3 letters of recommendation (teachers and guidance counselors, clergy or community leaders), and
4. Graduating high school seniors will be considered for scholarships first.
5. Financial need.

Award Determination:

The amount of the scholarships awarded each student varies based on funds available and the number of applicants for that year.

Scholarship Disbursement:

All Scholarship Awards will be sent directly to the attending institution for disbursement on behalf of the student.
